March Demonstration:

Judith Joseph showed her work and demonstrated working with egg tempera. Judith explained the history of egg tempera, traditionally done on wood panels. She works on both clay board panels and rag paper for her supports, combining egg tempera with Bombay India ink for lettering. Judith was attracted to this paint medium because of the intensity of the color, explaining it is a detail-loving medium. It is quick drying and has a nice potential for layering. Judith then demonstrated how she makes her paints with dry pigment and egg yolk. She hydrates her mixed paint on the palette just like acrylics.
